FROM THE DESK OF OUR MAYOR

Welcome Jim Weaver to the village council. Jim has been a resident in our village for more than 45 years. Jim has been a contributor to our village with projects such as the shelter house near Lake Iroquois, fishing with his grandchildren, and watching them play at the beach. Jim will be a terrific addition to our lakes and village maintenance committees.

Brice with Access Engineering and the Wayne Lakes Sewer committee report to you the status of the project. Work on the Sanitary Sewer Project will be resuming in late August with construction crews finishing the force main installation to the New Madison Wastewater Treatment Plant. This will take approximately 1 month to complete. After completion of the force main, work will begin on installing individual pumping tanks at each property in the village. Work on individual pumping tanks is expected to continue into the summer of 2025. Representatives of Degen Excavating and Access Engineering will be in touch with property owners to conduct an inspection of your house sanitary sewer and to discuss the location of the pumping tank. If you are not home when they visit your house a flyer will be left with contact information to schedule a visit. If you would like to schedule your visit ahead of time you can text Hans Steinke at 419-235-1201. We remain on budget.

Transfer Station: Is it the second Saturday of the month or the last and you see trucks driving past with their trash for the local transfer station? Do you need assistance with getting your trash to the station? Please give me a call to help with assistance. This will be a volunteer activity. Leave a message at 937-459-4111.

The Lakes Committee is reporting that three lakes need repair. Plan to skim Shawnee, Iroquois boat ramp and a floating wetland. Sauk lake is being reviewed for cleaning.
