Construction is projected to start this coming Spring 2023. 2023 rates are being updated to be set at \$35 per month starting in 2023, \$105 per quarter.

Goose pairing season is here. Please follow the general goose harassment guidelines provided by Ohio Department of Natural Resources. Please **do not** destroy nests. This causes an adverse reaction from the geese making them replace the lost nest. Geese do not know that all of the eggs will not hatch. Village personnel will addle eggs following guidelines provided. This reduces the large numbers hatching.

Plans for tree trimming in the village are currently under way. Pink ribbons are marking village trees that may be getting chopped soon. More to come.



Next council meeting Monday, March 13, 2023 7:00 p.m. in the council meeting room.


