**Canadian Geese** in just a few years a pair can easily become 50 to 100. DO NOT FEED GEESE! Canadian Geese are protected under the Federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act and Ohio State Law. Approved scare tactics include pyrotechnics, dogs, barriers, laser pointers (at night), distress calls, grape-flavored repellents. Non-lethal scare and hazing tactics, which do not harm the geese.

**Your tax dollars at work**. Dredging has been completed at Iroquois, Cherokee and Ess lakes. This is an effort to clean the areas near our drains. Keep that water flowing!

**Fish, Fish and More Fish!!!** The village has an order for this season. Blue Gills, Red Ears, Crappie and Perch.
