FROM THE DESK OF OUR MAYOR

Please vote in the November election. I received a call from the Darke County Board of Elections this week. The November election will remain in the Neave Township building. The good news is that we were approved to hold the March Primary in 2024 in our Community Building. The repairs were completed, but not soon enough to make the deadline to hold the November election.

Did you know that the current levy on the ballot is a renewal for current expenses. It is estimated that a property with a value of \$100,000 will pay \$245 towards the village. What does that help purchase? Chipping of branches, trees removed from roadways after storms, night lights on our roadways, snow removal, treatment and work on our lakes, trash pick up near our lakes, weed control and trimming, support for our beach and community building and much much more.

Brice with Access Engineering and the Wayne Lakes Sewer committee continue to work on the upcoming project. Pipe drilling is 2/3 of the way complete in our village. The drilling continues through South Creek Drive, North Drive, Poplar Lane, Evergreen Dr, Cross and North Middle Drive. An updated map will be provided on our website and at the local office. Please contact the village office with any questions or concerns. **Newly updated** mailers will be sent next quarter revealing the updated potential bill that may be expected due to our latest grant award. Doing all we can to lower those bills.

Trick or Treat is scheduled to start at the Community Building on the last Sunday, October 29, from 2 to 4pm. We are working to provide hayrides, games, give-a-ways, costume contests for all age groups, chili cook off competition.

We are seeking volunteers to help with new playground placement and installation. Please contact the village office if you have the desire to pitch in and make our park a better place for our children.
