One Call NowLatest items for our residents... sign up for One Call Now. This system has you send a text message to 22300 and you will be included in village updates such as: meeting reminders, tree down, harsh weather, opinion polls and more. You can opt out at any time. Data rates may apply.

Village Lake Cleanup....Due to Hurricane Helene approximately 9 trees have fallen into our lakes. This causes serious problems for the drain system which feeds most of the lakes. When trees fall into the lake, at this time of year, leaves tend to gather at the spot of the fallen tree. This situation causes a blockage of our system. Council has approved a **ONE TIME** clean up by our village maintenance staff and volunteers. Any future trees are the responsibility of each homeowner to remove at their cost.

No to Open Burning...The Ohio Division of Forestry prohibits open burning in unincorporated areas from 6 am to 6 pm during March, April, May, **October**, and November. This ban applies to yard waste, trash, and debris, even in a burn barrel.

Leaf dumpsters are available at the village garage on Main Drive. Residents can bag their leaves or use small trailers to dump them in the open dumpster. This is for residents only living within the village. Please do not put other trash or construction items in this dumpster.

Electric Aggregate letters are available at the village office. If you are not able to get an email copy of our newsletter. Paper copies are available for residents. The village aggregate company is Dynegy for 2025.

Daily Fishing Passes are easily purchased at the village office, on our village web page www.villageofwaynelakes.com and our Facebook page The Village of Wayne Lakes. Fall office hours are Thursdays from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. A daily pass is \$8.50. The non-resident passes are \$65 for the year.
