Completed projects in 2024 were:

- 1. V gates built and installed improving water flow at lakes Cherokee, Iroquois, and Ess lakes.
- 2. Gravel added to all boat ramps and parking areas to allow access to lakes.
- 3. Purchasing fish completed and evaluated annually.
- 4. Shelter houses are newly roofed, and maintenance will continue to scrape, sand, and stain all poles and gable ends.
- 5. Cleaning out and removing sediment from years of building up in lakes near drains.
- 6. A/C installed in the community building.
- 7. The beach ran in the summer 7 days per week open to the public.
