Ordinance 2025-04-01-001 Prohibiting Recreational Marijuana Dispensaries, Cultivators, and Processors within the village has been adopted.

Ordinance 2025-04-21-002 Regulation of Peddlers and Solicitors in the village has been adopted. They must register at the village office and purchase a permit.

The 2025 Catfish Tournament is currently planned for June 14th 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm on the Saturday before Father's Day. Lakes treated Algonquin, Shawnee, Kickapoo, Seneca, Iroquois, Ess. Next will be Chippewa, Cherokee. Lakes will be retreated as needed. Mosquito spraying June 13th & July 9th.

Application being submitted for Darke County Parks grant. Priority 1. LED message board for village office at entrance to village. To include meeting dates and safety alerts for residents. Priority 2. Paving the office parking area to create handicap spaces to enable our residents and guests to purchase fishing passes and obtain information.

Fishing Pass Price Increase.... Nonresident pass \$80 per year (online sales) Senior Citizen passes \$60 per year (in office purchase). Resident pass remains \$5 per year. Guest passes have been increased to five per resident household. The guest pass cost remains \$25 per pass (in office purchase). Daily passes online remain \$8.50 per day (online sales).

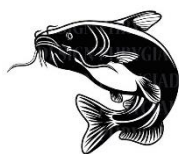
