Lakes Treatment....It takes 10 to 12 days for the chemical to kill duckweed. Lake Sauk and Shawnee are currently being treated. Thank you for your patience. The village is very fortunate to have volunteers to donate their time to making our lakes more plentiful and vibrant with stocking. Creating an environment for them to thrive. Our village is blessed indeed.

Beach Opening......Food coming soon. Hot pretzels with cheese, Nachos with cheese. Only 3 weekends left to enjoy our beach. The summer season is winding down, bring the kids and have a hot pretzel. Thank you to all the volunteers that made this year possible.

Darke County Commissioners submit the Wayne Lakes Critical Infrastructure Grant application. The grant is for \$475,000 for road repair on main roads in the village. The village share is \$25,000 for a total of \$500,000. Results should be posted in September of 2025 if the application is accepted.

Fishing Pass Prices....Nonresident pass \$80 per year (online sales) Senior Citizen passes \$60 per year (in office purchase). Resident pass remains \$5 per year. Guest passes have been increased to five per resident household. The guest pass cost remains \$25 per pass (in office purchase). Daily passes online remain \$8.50 per day (online sales).


