

RESOLUTION 2026-03-16-005

**A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN OUTDOOR WARNING SIREN ANNUAL PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE INSPECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN FEDERAL FIELD SERVICES, L.L.C. (FFS) AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE, AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Wayne lakes maintains an outdoor warning siren system essential for public safety and emergency notification; and

**WHEREAS**, regular preventative maintenance and inspection are necessary to ensure the continued reliability, functionality, and readiness of the outdoor warning sirens; and

**WHEREAS**, Federal Field Services has submitted a proposal to provide annual preventative maintenance and inspection services for the outdoor warning siren system; and

**WHEREAS**, Federal Field Services is qualified and experienced in providing such services and has demonstrated the capability to maintain the system in accordance with industry standards; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the Village of Wayne Lakes to enter into an agreement with Federal Field Services to perform these services for the protection and welfare of the community.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the legislative authority of the Village of Wayne Lakes, Darke County, Ohio, at least three-fourths of its members elected or appointed thereto concurring:


**SECTION ONE:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into and execute an agreement with Federal Field Services for the annual preventative maintenance and inspection of the outdoor warning siren system, according to the terms and conditions set forth in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A.


**SECTION TWO:** The cost of said agreement shall be paid from the appropriate fund designated for public safety or emergency management services.

- Electromechanical Sirens
- Cost per Site \$500.00
- Repairs identified during inspection that takes less than fifteen (15) minutes and require less than ten dollars (\$10.00) work of parts will be completed at no charge. However, repairs exceeding these parameters are not covered under this agreement, an estimate will be submitted for approval
- Agreement effective Jan 2026 – Dec 2026

**SECTION THREE:** This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage, as the timely maintenance of the outdoor warning siren system is necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety.
