WHEREAS, the Village of Wayne Lakes, Ohio needs to enter into a contract for fire services for the year 2026; and

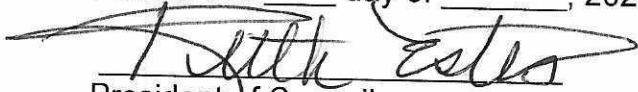
WHEREAS, the Village of Wayne Lakes, Ohio desires to contract with New Madison Fire Department for fire protection services;

FIRE SERVICES CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 24th day of November, 2025 to be effective January 1, 2026, by and between Neave Township, Darke County, Ohio, by the Trustees of said Township, and the New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, Inc, a private volunteer fire company, by and between its officers:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the said Neave Township Trustees desire to discharge the duty incumbent upon them of providing fire protection to the residents of Neave Township, and the New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, Inc., has indicated a willingness to provide said service upon a contract basis and to assume such other obligations as hereinafter set forth:

1. The New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, agrees to answer fire calls from Neave Township and its inhabitants and send apparatus and firemen thereto for the purpose of extinguishing fires in like manner as fire calls are answered and fires extinguished, for a period of one (1) year, beginning on the 1st day of January, 2026 and ending on the 31st of December, 2026
2. Neave Township, in consideration of the above, agrees to pay 86% to the New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, Inc of the net revenue generated by the tax millage from the Neave Township Fire Levies, payable in semi-annual installments in June and December.
3. It is understood by New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, Inc., that it shall obtain and maintain a suitable number of fire apparatus and vehicles, and to employ or use properly trained personnel FOLLOWING State of Ohio requirements.
4. The New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, Inc. shall obtain and maintain, in force, adequate property and liability insurance coverage for all New Madison Community Vol Fire Company, Inc. fire apparatus, vehicles, and New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, Inc. personnel, which shall include an insurance policy with minimum liability coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000, that names the Township as an additional insured. Copies of the New Madison Community

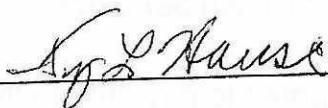
Vol. Fire Company, Inc. insurance policy naming the Township as an additional insured shall be provided to the Township within ninety (90) days of the execution of this Fire Services Contract.

5. The New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, Inc. shall require that all individuals appointed as firefighters become certified as basic firefighters within one (1) year of the date of appointment. The New Madison Community Vol. Fire Company, Inc. shall require all firefighters on its active roster comply with the State of Ohio Continuing Education requirements for firefighters (54 hours every three (3) years). All members who might be required to use respiratory protection equipment shall be SCBA fit tested.
